New and fascinating information is revealed on best-known composer/clarinettist relationships such as Mozart with Anton Stadler, Weber with Heinrich Baermann, Spohr with Simon Hermstedt and Brahms with Richard Muhlfeld. Further subjects include the following: clarinettists of the French Revolution (including a map of Paris showing where they lived), Russia s clarinet dynasty, early 19th-century female performers, the great Finnish clarinettist Crussell whose diary tells of French Revolution events and a Napoleonic military parade, Verdi s clarinettist Cavallini who played for and was on familiar terms with the Tsar, the full stories of Stanford s concerto (it was Pamela Weston who got this beautiful work published for the first time, fifty years after the composer s death) and Ireland s Fantasy-Sonata (how the composer worked with the Sonata s dedicatee, Frederick Thurston).
